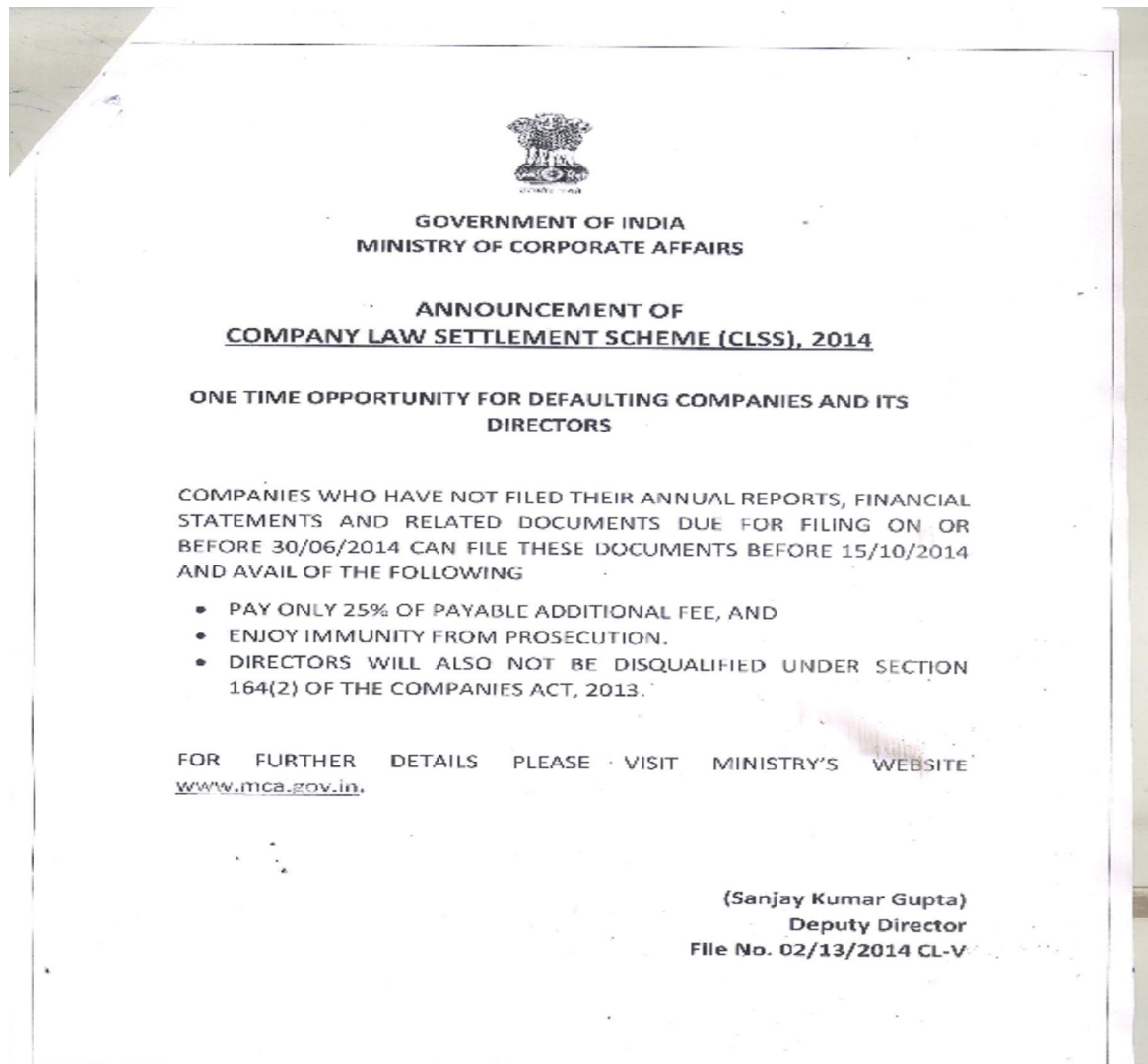

Note on the co-ordination committee meeting held on 25th August, 2014 at CETP followed by Site Visit

Present :

Visited NMMC's Solid Waste Dumping Ground at Turbhe. Mr.Raju Halande, JE, NMMC and Mr.Narayan Rao, Sr.GM, Navi Mumbai Waste Processing Co.P.Ltd welcomed the team.

It was informed to the NMMC officials that TBIA has received complaints from the member industries located nearby NMMC's dumping ground at Turbhe that leachate from NMMC dumping ground is flowing to their premises. The matter has been taken by TBIA to NMMC officials from time to time.

The purpose of the visit is to understand the action taken by NMMC in preventing leachate from the dumping ground.

Mr.Raju Halande and Mr.Narayana Rao briefed to the committee on NMMC's Integrated Municipal Solid Waste Processing unit at Turbhe as :

- NMMC is getting 500-700 MT Municipal Solid Waste per day. This is segregated for organic and inorganic waste at presorting.
- Organic Waste is processed in windrows to make compost.
- Organic Waste breakdown into enormous numbers of micro-organism during composting process.
- The micro-organism takes moisture and oxygen from air and food from organic waste. They reproduce themselves. Some of the energy is used for growth and movement. The rest energy is tries to conserve in a compost heap.
- The heap passes through warms up, peak temperature, cools down at different stages. Adequate supply of air to all heaps helps to supply oxygen for organisms.
- After 30 days cycle of composting the organic matter, same is passed through trammels to obtain less than 4 mm size organic manure which can be used as manure for agriculture, horticulture cultivation enabling the soil to keep in good structure and fertility for long period of time.
- Non-biodegradable waste is formed into Residual Derived Fuel Bricks in RDF Unit.
- Mixed Plastic from waste is collected, cleaned and made into Agglomerated Plastic.

Leachate collection and treatment :

NMMC has a leachate collection and treatment plant to treat 90 KL per day. Presently, NMMC is getting 60 KL per day leachate and same is treated in the plant. The total treated water is reusing for the development of greenery.

During monsoon, they receive excess water. MPCB officials informed to NMMC officials that NMMC's Solid Waste Dumping Ground to become member of CETP. The excess leachate water can be sent to CETP by tanker. This will ensure no leachate water from the dumping ground flows to the nearby industries / nallaha / gutter etc.

NMMC has agreed to become member of CETP as per the guidelines of CETP.

Visit to BASF India Ltd :

The committee visited BASF India Ltd, located at Turbhe. Mr.Sachin Joshi and Mr.Ajay Bagul welcomed the team.

Visited their ETP Plant :

Mr.Sachin and Mr.Bagul explained to the visiting team that BASF have primary, secondary and tertiary treatment before discharging to MIDC drainage line.

Environment Improvement and Energy Conservation undertaken by BASF :

- Converted to PNG
- BASF has reduced water consumption from 660 M3 to 450 M3.
- 30% of recycled water is reused.
- Street Light, Boiler Feed Water, engineering building etc. are run by solar energy.
- 6000 trees planted inside their factory premises.

The detailed site report will be prepared by MPCB.

Report on Joint visit to M/s.Pharmaceutical Coatings P.Ltd located at Plot No.C-318, Pawne, TTC Area on 26th August, 2014 :

Mr.Hemant Pradhan, MD of M/s. Pharmaceutical Coatings P.Ltd and Mr.C.J.Thakkar briefed to the NMMC/MIDC Officials on the various problem being faced by them. Since, theirs is a Pharma unit, they have to keep surrounding neat and clean. They have received many national export awards.

Action decided on the following grievances are as under :

- **Bad Condition of the road** : Contacted NMMC officials, according to them, NMMC has the approved to construct asphalt road with drain. This work will start immediately after monsoon.
- **Cleaning of drainage line** : Contacted Mr.Diwadkar of CETP. He has agreed to send his official to take immediate action.
- **Garbage collection** : Mr.Sanadi has agreed to collect the garbage regularly. He has also agreed to keep a garbage bin nearby the company.
- **Remove the mobile toilet parked in front of the company** : To take up the matter with the Ward Office, Turbhe.
- **Removal of hutment** : Requested to MIDC to remove the hutment from the road width. MIDC Official agreed to take up the matter with the higher authority.

After a month, a review meeting will be held.
